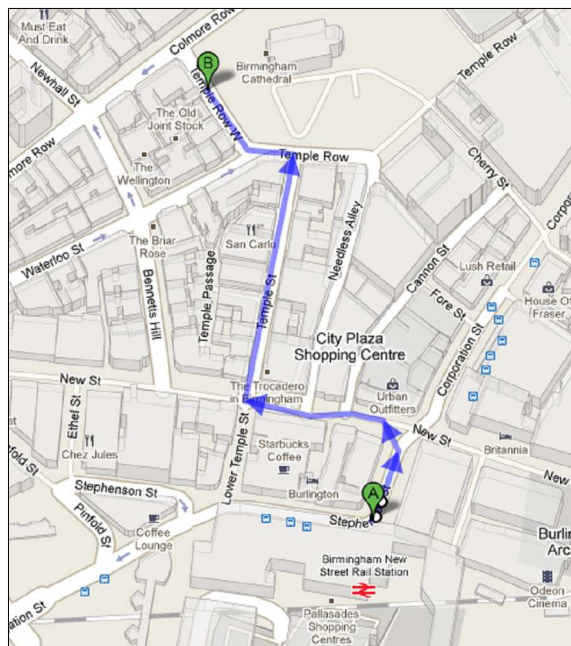

Travelling by public transport

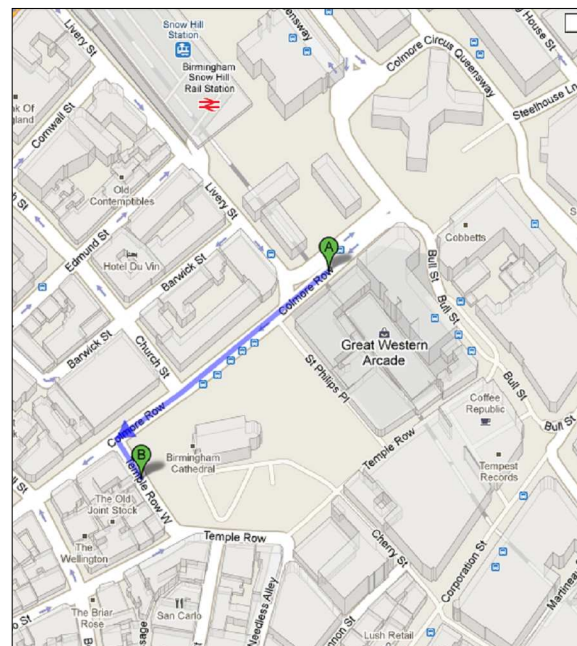
From Birmingham New St station:

Follow the signs for the station's Main Exit. On entering the station concourse (after the ticket barriers), follow the escalators up to the Pallasades Shopping Centre, turn left at the top and continue until The Perfume Shop, then turn right. Exit the shopping centre by going down the ramp towards New Street. At the bottom of the ramp (next to HSBC) turn left, cross the road and continue down New Street until you come to Tesco Metro on the right hand side, then turn right onto Temple Street. Walk up to the top of the hill, and as you enter St Philips (Cathedral) Square, turn left following the road round the square. You'll pass the Old Joint Stock pub on your left and our office is immediately next door to it.



From Birmingham Snow Hill station:

Exit the station via the main exit. Turn right onto Colmore Row and walk towards the Cathedral that is diagonally to your right as you exit the station. Keeping the Cathedral on your left walk along Colmore Row, to the end of the square and turn left onto Temple Row West. Our office is then on your right hand side.



By bus:

Travelling by car

Parking

Parking in central Birmingham is difficult so you may find it cheaper and easier to use "Park and Ride" by train or metro. There are quite a few stations which are reasonably accessible from the motorways and have free parking. For details have a look at the Network West Midlands website (www.networkwestmidlands.com). The rail map shows you stations with car parking facilities.

If you need to park near the office, the multi-storey car parks tend to fill up before 10am and street parking can be expensive. Cheaper car parks and street parking can be found to the west of the A38 in the city centre. Otherwise there are shopping car parks (e.g. Bullring) but these are mainly short stay.

Directions

From the M6, join the A38(M) and continue towards the city centre. Once you have gone over the flyover, take the slip road on the left (signposted Business car park, Jewellery Quarter and West Bromwich A41) turn left at the traffic lights (Snow Hill Queensway) and there is parking at Snow Hill Station on Livery Street.

From the South on the M5, take Junction three, keep following the road straight on through traffic lights and through the underpass signposted Broad Street. When you come to the end of Broad Street, follow the signs for Snow Hill Station.

Otherwise, follow the ring road (A4540) around to Dartmouth Circus then take the A38 towards the City Centre (Central Area) and follow the M6 instructions above.
